Rationale

The admissions limit set for the school is 80. Admissions are currently managed by Herefordshire Local Authority, but as an Academy School from 1st December 2011 the Governing Body can consider making its own arrangements.

Governors have taken the decision that the school will continue to use the Herefordshire local authority admissions service for both administering school admissions and for the determination of eligibility for places should the school become oversubscribed for the admissions process 2018/2019.

All parameters used within the accepted authority version in respect of allocation of places will apply, and where the PAN is exceeded the document will be used as the benchmark in determining eligibility for a place at Queen Elizabeth High School.
